FEES

❖ **Registration Fee:** \$10.00 per family (All students eligible to attend will need to be registered yearly.)

Full Time - A.M. & P.M. \$55.00
Before School - A.M. only \$38.00
After School - P.M. only \$38.00

• Each additional child in a family will pay:

\$30.00 A.M./P.M.
\$20.00 A.M. or P.M. only

• School weeks having less than five days will have prorated fees.

❖ **Drop-In Fees:** Students who attend irregularly during the week are referred to as “drop-in”.

A.M. or P.M. \$10.00/visit
A.M. and P.M. \$15.00/visit

**Childcare will be available on the following half days/afternoons that school is not in session:

❖ **Half-Day Additional Charge:**
